Risk Register

- GBF Project Drakelow Park deallocated £5.05M funding, See below for further details:
- Strategic Objectives to be reviewed to reflect current LEP environment and future 2023-24
 Delivery Plan proposed risks.
- Removed risk that identified that Achieve Training, delivering the GBF project Cleveland Future Skills Hub, is to close.

LEP Core Budget and Reserves

- At Q4 22-23, the LEP Core Budget was initially anticipated to underspend by c£0.071m.
- Following a review of the 22-23 LEP Core Budget by A&F, Hatch consultancy costs have now been included in the forecast and are to be funded from the current forecast underspend.
- Hatch consultancy costs are, however, expected to be higher than initially estimated given the number of GBF Grant Reallocation business cases that have been submitted (see GBF Grant section below). Total Hatch consultancy contract costs are yet to be finalised.
- Legal fees are also expected to be higher (£0.030m est.) than currently forecast to reflect additional legal support required with the drafting and issuing of new GBF Grant Funding Agreements to successful applicants.
- Adjusting the Q4 22-23 LEP Core Budget forecast for the inclusion of both Hatch consultancy contract costs and revised GBF Grant legal fees has resulted in the forecast LEP Core Budget underspend being revised down to c£0.032m.
- Total Unrestricted LEP Reserves are estimated at £1.737m (as at 31st March 23).

GBF Grant Reallocation Update

- Open Call ended 12pm 17th February 2023.
- 16 Business Cases received.
- Over £25 million of Grant funding being requested.
- Stage 1 of the eligibility process completed CEO, S151 Officer, Change Manager
- ITA currently being undertaken.

- SPMG 9th March selection process.
- Executive Board 16th March ratification.
- Post 16th March contracting with successful projects.
